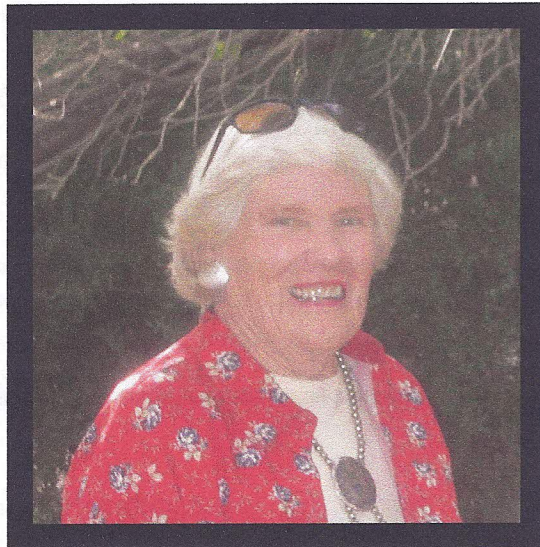


# Plain Brown Rapper
